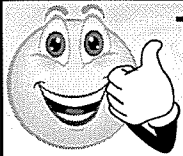
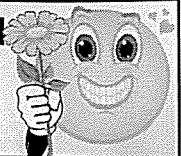

## **AFFIRM - 10th year celebration**

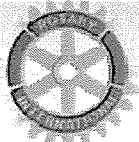
This year the Aranui Community Trust and the AFFIRM working party are bringing home two of our stars.

Ladi6 and Dallas Tamaira are confirmed performers for this years 'homegrown' AFFIRM celebration which is now in it's 10th year.



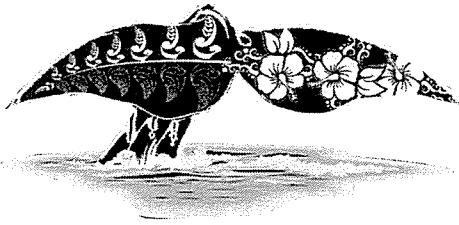
Ladi6 is a contemporary R&B singer and rapper and started her musical career as part of New Zealand's first all-girl hip-hop group Sheelaroc.

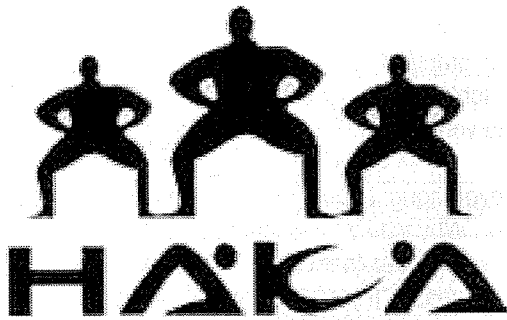

### TEAM MAKE-UP AND RULES:

- ⇒ Teams must consist of 8 members maximum, will be mixed and 70% of team must either work or live in Aranui. Teams must have 2 youth (1 male and 1 female) aged 13-17 years, a maximum of 4 adult males and at least 2 adult females.
- ⇒ The entry cost per team is \$20. This is to be paid when registering your team.
- ⇒ The team must: Come up with your team name; Provide your own 'funky' team t-shirt; Bring your own filled water bottle and towel.

Registrations cost \$20 per team and can be picked up from ACTIS. Completed forms must be received at ACTIS, 37 Hampshire St, by Monday 7th November. LIMIT of 16 teams ONLY - Be in quick !!!
